Mr. Walter Marlin Parker was born November 29, 1926, in the Fairplay Community of Panola County, Texas. He passed this life September 16, 2023, in Carthage, Texas. He was born to the marriage of James Alton and Amanda McLeroy Parker. He was a graduate of Carthage High School with the Bulldog class of 1944 where he was a member of the CHS band, playing the trumpet. Later in life when he couldn't play the trumpet anymore, he settled for playing the harmonica. After graduation, he was drafted into the U.S. Army and served in the South Pacific. He received the Asiatic Pacific Campaign Medal, Philippine Independence Ribbon and World War II Victory Medal.

Walter married Mary Ault on November 6, 1958 in Longview, Texas and to their marriage was born two sons, Marlin Scott and Mark David Parker. Walter was a rancher and used auto parts broker. He retired from the auto parts business in 1994 and remained a rancher until his death. He was preceded in death by his son Mark David Parker, a brother Tracy Parker and wife Sue and two baby sisters, Alma and Agnes Parker.

Mr. Parker is survived by his loving wife Mary, a son Scott Parker and wife Belinda; grandchildren, Chase Parker, Shelbi Pittman and husband Matt and

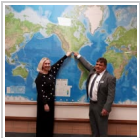
