Mr. W. C. McMillan was born May 26, 1915 in Logansport, Louisiana. He was one of four children born to the marriage of Mann and Ethel Newman McMillan. He was schooled and graduated from Logansport attending Panola Junior College. He served his country through the U. S. Army where he served in the Tank Corp., receiving two purple hearts. He married Lucille Margaret Gentry December 12, 1940 and they celebrated 60 years of marriage before she preceded him in death in 2001. W.C. worked as the Panola County Treasurer, and spent many years working for the Hawthorn Life Insurance Company. He was a longtime member of the First Baptist Church of Carthage and a dedicated Berean Sunday School Class member.
