



## Rev. William "Jack" Calvin Willis

May 26, 1930 - September 24, 2014

Funeral services for Rev. William Calvin "Jack" Willis, 84, of the Galloway Community will be 1:00 p.m. Saturday, September 27, 2014 at the Faith Assembly of God Church with Rev. Joe Freeman and Rev. Roger Hoffpawier officiating. Burial will follow in the Adams Cemetery under the direction of Hawthorn Funeral Home. Family visitation will be 6-8:00 p.m. Friday night at the funeral home. Rev. Willis died Wednesday, September 24, 2014 in Marshall, Texas.

Rev. William Calvin Willis was born May 26, 1930 in the Galloway Community of Panola County, Texas. He was the baby of six children born to Marion F. and Ivous Kirby Willis. He served his country through the U.S. Army where he received his high school diploma and served three years. He married Mary Ann White on June 18, 1949 and they celebrated 63 years of marriage until she preceded him in death on September 28, 2012. Rev. Willis would go on to earn his Doctorate of Religious Education and honorary Doctorate in Literature from the International Theological Seminary. Rev. Willis was a missionary to Indonesia, Malaysia, Belgium and Nepal. He loved his Lord and family above all else. He is also preceded in death by his parents, four sisters, a brother and a son, William Craig Willis.
